





IMPACT

Quantitative analysis demonstrates a **statistically significant positive impact on all aspects measured** including participants' understanding of university, student finance as well as A-level and degree choice.

¹ Calculated using a two-tailed paired difference test ($\alpha = 0.01$) using matched pre- and post-residential survey responses which were given as 5-point scales in response to questions such as “Do you feel well equipped to choose a university course?” and “How much do you know about the following aspects of university?”.
